

**Measurements:**

1. Start with the first wall on the left and work to your right all the way around the room. First, measure the overall length of each wall in your kitchen. Use of grid paper makes it easier to record your measurements.
2. Indicate all breaks in walls (windows, doors, closets...) by measuring from the corner to the outside edge of the molding. Don't forget to indicate any permanent appliances, air vents, offsets, etc.
3. Measure to the centerline of plumbing, ducting, and outlets. Remember that plumbing and outlets may be moved to accommodate a design.
4. Measure the height of the ceiling from the floor.
